A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST EASTON, COUNTY OF NORTHAMPTON, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, SUPPORTING THE COUNTRY OF UKRAINE IN THE UNPROVOKED WAR STARTED BY RUSSIA

WHEREAS, on February 24, 2022, the country of Russia invaded the sovereign nation of Ukraine without provocation, or legitimate reason, and did begin an act of war against Ukraine; and

WHEREAS, the President of Russia, Vladimir Putin, seeks to remove the legitimate and democratically elected government of Ukraine through the use of military force; and

WHEREAS, the Russian military is targeting Ukrainian civilian communities with missiles, cannon, bombs, and rockets, with the result of causing death and injury to non-combatants, including women and children; and

WHEREAS, the United States, the European Union, and other nations support Ukraine by imposing sanctions upon Russia, and/or providing weapons and humanitarian aid to Ukraine; and

WHEREAS, Ukraine has refused to surrender, demonstrating the will of its military and civilians whose bravery, and determination to remain democratic and independent, has garnered the admiration of free nations around the world; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved The Borough of West Easton Council supports Ukraine and its people in their fight against Russia, and those supporting the same, whether by rally, demonstration, or visual display.
